

Public Submission Information

Invitation for Public Comment on the strategic assessment of impacts of a Plan for mining iron ore and associated infrastructure in the Pilbara region of Western Australia

On 18 September 2012 the Commonwealth Minister for Sustainability, Environment, Water, Population and Communities and BHP Billiton Iron Ore Vice President Health, Safety, Environment and Community agreed to undertake a strategic assessment of impacts of a Plan for mining iron ore and associated infrastructure in the Pilbara region of Western Australia under the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999*.

The Strategic Assessment will facilitate a more holistic and longer term view of mining activities in the Pilbara region by identifying and assessing how impacts to the environment at a landscape scale will be managed.

Public comments from interested parties are invited for a period of at least 28 days (as specified by the Minister) on the two Strategic Assessment documents, the draft MNES Program and the draft Impact Assessment Report which consider the impacts of actions on Matters of National Environmental Significance in accordance with the requirements of the Agreement.

The documents will be available for public comment from 21 March to 2 May 2016.
