

Commencing 16 February 2021, BMA issued notices of representational rights to Employees of BHP Coal covered by BMA Enterprise Agreement 2018 in relation to the BMA Enterprise Agreement 2022 (**EA**).

Since then, BMA has met with the bargaining representatives for employees to discuss the Agreement and finalise its terms. All parties have agreed to put a proposed agreement to a ballot. We are now commencing the Access Period to put the Agreement to ballot of our EA employees.

The access period commences on Wednesday 7th December and concludes on Saturday 17th December 2022.

Voting process

The vote will be conducted by an electronic ballot, and details of the ballot are **attached**.

The vote will be open on Sunday 18th December 2022 at 6:00am and voting will close at midday AEST on Thursday 22nd December 2022.

Application to the Fair Work Commission for approval

If a majority (50% + 1 of employees who return a valid vote) approve the Agreement, BMA will file an application for approval by the Fair Work Commission within 14 days.

To lodge your vote by telephone, please follow these steps:

1. To prepare to lodge your vote by telephone, ensure you have:

- a. Your **Employee Number** and your **Date of Birth** and a piece of paper and a pen to record your receipt number.
- 2. Dial 1300 146 388 (International +61 3 9900 4982) and follow the audio prompts.

Only votes successfully lodged before 12:00pm (noon) AEST on Thursday, 22nd December 2022 will be counted. You are only able to vote once and all votes are registered anonymously.
