**Testing** 

• As part of your invitation to apply to the Talent Network, you will also be required to enter some personal details and answer some relevant application questions. It's really important you complete these - the more information we have, the better we can align you to the right team member for further discussion.

· After speaking with one of our Strategic Sourcing Specialists, you will receive an email inviting you to join our Talent Network. You will be asked to upload

**Interviews** 

- Right away! In your initial discussion with a Strategic Sourcing team member, you will receive feedback on your CV, experiences and where you could potentially be suited for future opportunities with BHP.
- If you are considered for a specific role, a good rule of thumb is around two weeks between stages or update emails. Hopefully, this will be the longest you would wait, and if it takes a little longer, it doesn't mean you've been unsuccessful.
